Freestyle Rules and Regulations

Freestyle sessions are posted on our website. A maximum of 10 participants and 5 coaches will be allowed on the ice surface per hour session. At this time, Ice Dancing, Pair Skating and contact coaching is not allowed on freestyle sessions. Coaches are asked to coach only from the boards.

A Guest Coach must submit the <u>Guest Coach Information Sheet</u> to the skating director, Karen Cohen-Prosnitz, at <u>karenC@icevault.com</u>, prior to coming into the facility or teaching lessons.

Temperatures are checked when participants sign in and pay for each 1 hour session at the front office. Participants will <u>enter</u> the ice at the main entrance and <u>exit</u> using the door by the bleachers.

Face covering is required when entering the facility and after exiting the ice. Skaters are not required to wear a mask while on the ice. Coaches are required to wear a mask at all time. Parents must wear face coverings when inside the facility.

Participants are expected to follow social distance guidelines at all times, both on and off the ice.

All participants must have a cell phone number of a parent/guardian for emergencies.

Only water bottles and tissues kept in pockets are allowed on the boards. Please remove all bottles after the session is over.

Parents are asked to remain outside the rink or in their vehicles, not in the lobby or by the ice surface. The restaurant, party rooms and all locker rooms are closed. There is no congregating allowed in the lobby or common areas. A parent may sit socially distanced in the bleachers.

Skaters must arrive no earlier than 15 minutes before the scheduled session, and leave no later than 15 minutes after the session.

These rules, guidelines and procedures are in place to ensure the safety and well-being of our skating families. As guidelines change, we will update and post.
